Aula de Comércio was born in 1989. It's a private educational project, which values an active participation and a strong connection to the corporate world and to the community in general. Its aim is to open new horizons to all those who intend to obtain a vocational qualification or to develop knowledge and skills in the trade and services field. Escola de Comércio de Lisboa is promoted by Aula de Comércio-Estudos Técnicos e Profissionais, Lda., which currently has as partners ENSINUS – Empreendimentos Educativos SA and CCP - Confederação do Comércio e Serviços de Portugal (Social Partner). This organisation was named after the Marquês de Pombal initiative. In 1759, Marquês de Pombal launched the commerce studies in Portugal. ECL has some 500 students and 75 teachers/trainers.

KEY ACTIVITIES

1. Vocational School: EU level 4 qualification and Secondary Certification

- Vocational/Professional Courses: Commerce Technician, Sales Technician, Marketing Technician, Window Dressing Technician, Events Management Technician, Reception Technician, Restaurant-Bar Technician;

- Apprenticeship Course: Computer Networks Technician;

- Secondary Vocational Courses: Logistics Technician (in a partnership with SONAE); Communication and Digital Service Technician and Retailing Technician.

Aside from the secondary vocational courses, since the beginning that Escola de Comércio de Lisboa embraced the Elementary Vocational Courses, level 2 in Commercial Employee, Information Technology and Restaurant|Food Service.

2. In-Company Training - studies for Trade and Services and implementing Training Programmes aiming the professional development of workers;

3. Career Management Department – Databases for Work Placements, Candidates and Employers.

3. Qualifica Center: the government assigned us in 2017 with a “Qualifica Center”, that is, a center linked to the «Qualifica» Program which deals with adults and younger qualification and employability. The «Qualifica» Program targets adult qualification and is aimed to increase the levels of education and training, contributing to the improvement of employability.
